


Exports are a significant portion of Illinois' economy

- Since 2002, Illinois exports have grown \$39.1 billion
- Illinois exports totaled over \$64.8 billion in 2011, \$14.8 billion more than 2010 or a 29.5% increase
- Illinois' 2011 export growth was nearly double the average U.S. export growth of 16%
- Illinois ranks as the #1 state for exports in the Midwest and as the 5th largest exporting state in the U.S.
- Direct exports accounted for 9.7% of the Gross State Product (GSP) in 2011
- Illinois ranks #1 between the Coasts for exports

Geographic breakdown for Illinois' \$14.8 billion export growth in 2011

- 85.9% of growth came from top 20 markets
- Largest single contributor to growth: Canada \$4.5 billion growth over 2010 (29.6%)
- Highest growth in top 20 markets: Australia \$1.33 billion growth over 2010 (55.9%)
- Notable growth markets: Mexico \$1.4 billion (34.1%); China \$0.7 billion (22.4%); UK \$0.7 billion (39.5%); Brazil \$0.5 billion (23.5%)

Industry breakdown for Illinois' \$14.8 billion export growth in 2011

- 96.1% of growth came from top 10 industries
- Largest single contributor to growth: Machinery \$5.3 billion growth over 2010 (42.8%)
- Highest growth industry: Petroleum and Coal Products \$2.1 billion growth over 2010 (206%)
- Notable growth industries: Chemicals \$2.0 billion (31.2%);
 Transportation Equipment \$1.3 billion (25.2%); All Agricultural and Food Products \$1.2 billion (28.6%)



Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in Illinois – 2012

- State of Illinois was ranked 7th among all states and Chicago 2nd among all metropolitan areas in locations for new and expanded corporate facilities by Site Selection magazine
- Chicago recently named #1 U.S. city for foreign direct investment and U.S. "city of the future" by Foreign Direct Investment Magazine
- Illinois ranks #1 in the Midwest as a destination for foreign investment
- Illinois has attracted 1,597 foreign firms with 6,416 locations
