



National Association of REALTORS® Ethics Requirement **Quadrennial Periods**

(Two-and-a-half hours of Code of Ethics training required)

REALTOR member of the association shall be required to complete quadrennial ethics training of not less than two hours and thirty minutes of instructional time. This requirement will be satisfied upon presentation of documentation that the member has completed a course of instruction conducted by this or another association, the State Association of REALTORS, the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS, or any other recognized educational institution or provider which meets the learning objectives and minimum criteria established by the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS from time to time. The quadrennial periods are as follows:

01/01/01 thru 12/31/04

01/01/05 thru 12/31/08

01/01/09 thru 12/31/2012

01/01/2013 thru 12/31/2016; thereafter.....

Different Ways to Complete This Requirement:

- 1. The MORE Education Dept. recommends Realtors® take an Ethics course as part of their state continuing education requirement. Not only will you receive “elective” continuing education credit; the Ethics course will coincide with NAR’s requirement. ****IMPORTANT**:** If you take your continuing education courses through another school, other than Mainstreet, it will be your responsibility to fax your ethics certificate of completion to 630-324-8403 for proof of completion.**
- 2. Visit www.Realtor.org. Click from the home page “Complete Your Code of Ethics Training”. This is a complimentary 2.5 hr. online course. You will take an exam at the end of the course. An e-mail of completion will be sent to you, and your local association, as well.**
- 3. For MORE new members, completing the 1.5 day orientation class will comply with the NAR mandate for that particular quadrennial period.**
