Placemaking Criteria

- **Benefits everyone in the community**
- **Accessible to the entire community all or most of the day**
- **At least 10 things to do; even if it's people watching, sitting, talking with a friend, etc.**
- **Community involvement is encouraged**
- **Incorporate REALTOR® involvement**
- **Provide project updates including photos**
- **REALTOR® recognition**
- **Reimbursement grant – invoices and receipts to be submitted for reimbursement. Initial funding must be in place before the start of the project. Invoices and receipts are due no later than December 1st, 2021**
- **Funds must be spent before the end of the year the grant was awarded**
- **Projects must take place within the Mainstreet jurisdiction**
- **Public, private, and nonprofit partners are encouraged**
